

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PLACE STOP SIGNS ON ELM STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH LAWRENCE STREET AND ON BULLPUP DRIVE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH ELM STREET IN ORDER TO PROVIDE TRAFFIC CONTROL AS DESIGNED FOR THE NEW INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, a platted section of Elm Street is being constructed as part of the project to build a new elementary school near Lawrence Street; and

WHEREAS, a platted section of Bullpup Drive is being constructed as part of the same project; and

WHEREAS, the traffic design for the construction of the new road provides for a stop sign to be placed on Elm Street at its intersection with Lawrence Street and a stop sign to be placed on Bullpup Drive at its intersection with Elm Street; and


WHEREAS, the Public Health & Safety Committee has recommended that such intersections be controlled as designed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN CITY:

- Section 1. City Staff is authorized to place stop signs on Elm Street at its intersection with Lawrence Street in order to provide traffic control as designed for the new intersection.
- Section 2. City Staff is authorized to place stop signs on Bullpup Drive at its intersection with Elm Street in order to provide traffic control as designed for the new intersection.
- Section 3. Said intersections shall be controlled as designed and such controls are enforceable by law enforcement.
