

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-02

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS SPECIFIC TO THE PUBLIC ALLEY BETWEEN THE 200 BLOCK OF EISENHOWER STREET AND THE 200 BLOCK OF WESLEY STREET IN BALDWIN CITY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Public Health & Safety Committee has discussed parking, traffic, and emergency accessibility issues specific to the nonconforming mobile home park that currently exists in the 200 Blocks of Wesley and Eisenhower Streets, such park property being bordered by Quayle Street to the north and Kibbee Street to the south; and

WHEREAS, the public alley between the 200 block of Eisenhower Street and the 200 block of Wesley Street is used, in practicality, as a route to provide primary access to up to twelve individual mobile home units in said mobile home park; and

WHEREAS, the "Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities", duly adopted by the City of Baldwin City, provides that no person shall park any vehicle in any alley except for the purpose of loading or unloading, and then and only for the duration of time as reasonably necessary to do so; and

WHEREAS, the governing body has adopted an ordinance allowing specific alleys to be exempted from said provision in the Standard Traffic Ordinance by resolution; and


WHEREAS, the governing body acknowledges that the specific alley in question is used much like a city street, including vehicles regularly parking on both sides of the alley which inhibits emergency vehicle access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the governing body of the City of Baldwin City, Kansas, that:

- Section 1. Parking shall be allowed in the specific public alley between the 200 block of Eisenhower Street and the 200 block of Wesley Street, bordered to the north by Quayle Street on to the south by Kibbee Street in Baldwin City, Kansas.
- Section 2. Although parking shall generally be allowed on both sides of said alley, no vehicles shall be parked on said alley within twenty (20) feet of the alley's intersections with Quayle Street or Kibbee Street rights-of-way.
- Section 3. "No Parking – Here to corner" signs may be erected so as to provide visibility to the regulation set forth in Section 2.


