

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-02

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND FIXING THE LOCATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ON LOCAL STREETS IN BALDWIN CITY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, recent changes in the use of USD No. 348 facilities on Chapel Street have caused the City to re-evaluate speed limits and traffic controls in the portion of the city bordered by Ames Street, Sixth Street, Dearborn Street, and Eighth Street; and


WHEREAS, the Public Health & Safety Committee has determined and recommended certain adjustments to traffic controls be made, and such are enumerated in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Baldwin City, Kansas, that:


- Section 1. Chapel Street between Sixth and Eighth Streets shall be marked and adjusted to accommodate two-way traffic.
- Section 2. The stop signs on Eighth Street at Chapel Street shall be removed.
- Section 3. The stop signs on Sixth Street at Chapel Street shall be removed. A stop sign shall be established on Chapel Street at Sixth Street for eastbound traffic.
- Section 4. Stop signs shall be installed on Sixth Street at Dearborn Street, establishing a four-way stop.
- Section 5. No parking shall be permitted on the south side of Chapel Street between Sixth Street and Eighth Street.
- Section 6. No parking shall be permitted on the west side of Seventh Street between Chapel Street and Dearborn Street.
