

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-29

A RESOLUTION EXEMPTING THE BALDWIN CITY POWER PLANT #2 FROM PROVISIONS OF HOUSE BILL NO. 2052 UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2017.

WHEREAS, provisions of House Bill No. 2052 allow municipal buildings to be exempt for an additional four years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Baldwin City has created a security plan for the Baldwin City Power Plant #2 in accordance with sections of House Bill No. 2052.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Baldwin City, Kansas:

Section 1. The following building is hereby exempted from the requirements of Kan. Sess. 2013 Ch. 105, Sec. 2 (i)

- Baldwin City Power Plant #2 - 1100 Orange Street

TRACT #1: BEGINNING AT A POINT 20 RODS SOUTH AND 75 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER (COMMON POINT OF THE FOUR QUARTERS) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE ¼) IN SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST; THENCE EAST 30 FEET; THENCE IN A SOUTHWESTERLY DIRECTION A DISTANCE OF 42.42 FEET; THENCE NORTH A DISTANCE OF 30 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS (CONTAINS 0.01 ACRES MORE OR LESS)

TRACT #2: BEGINNING AT A POINT 20 RODS SOUTH AND 125 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER (COMMON POINT OF THE FOUR QUARTERS) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE ¼) OF SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, THENCE NORTH 150 FEET; THENCE EAST 25 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 150 FEET; THENCE WEST 25 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, IN DOUGLAS COUNTY, KANSAS, (CONTAINS 0.086 ACRES, MORE OR LESS)

Section 2. The exemption is based on the analysis of the security plan completed on this building and the determination of the governing body that safety is sufficient to continue the ban on concealed weapons from this building.


Section 3. A security plan has been developed for the building being exempted which supplies adequate security to the occupants of the building and merits the prohibition of the carrying of a concealed handgun as authorized by the Personal and Family Protection Act. The prohibition shall continue until December 31, 2017.

Section 4. A copy of the security plan shall be maintained by the city clerk and will be provided to the Kansas Attorney General or local law enforcement upon request. The security plan is not subject to disclosure under the Kansas Open Records Act.
