

**RESOLUTION NO. 2016-17**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN CITY, KANSAS, IN SUPPORT OF THE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL DEBRIS MANAGEMENT PLAN.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2009, a Multi-Jurisdictional Debris Management Plan was adopted by all jurisdictions within Douglas County and

**WHEREAS**, guidance from FEMA necessitated an update and revision of this plan and

**WHEREAS**, a partnership between Douglas County Emergency Management and Public Works Departments of Douglas County, Lawrence, Baldwin City, Eudora, and Lecompton worked together to create an updated Multi-Jurisdictional Debris Management Plan and

**WHEREAS**, this plan was submitted and approved first by the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and then by the Federal Emergency Management Agency on May 23, 2016.



The Governing Body of the City of Baldwin City, Kansas authorizes and directs the City Administrator of Baldwin City to sign a resolution formally adopting this Multi-Jurisdictional Debris Management Plan to be implemented in the event of a disaster declaration to properly and efficiently deal with disaster debris operations in a manner that is consistent with FEMA guidelines and which can be replicated across each jurisdiction with Douglas County.
