

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-06

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BALDWIN CITY INTEGRATED RESOURCE PLAN AS PART OF THE WESTERN AREA POWER ADMINISTRATION QUALIFYING ALTERNATIVE PLAN FOR SMALL GENERATING CUSTOMERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Baldwin City, Kansas (City) is a customer of the Western Area Power Administration; and

WHEREAS, the Western Area Power Administration has integrated resource planning guidelines and as such the City has heretofore authorized certain internal improvements described as follows; and

WHEREAS, the EAct requires all Western Area Power Administration customers to submit IRPs to Western every five years, and the requirement is included in Western's power sales contracts with long-term firm customers. The current Resource Planning Approval Criteria (10 CFR Part 905) went into effect May 1, 2000, after Western reviewed the original regulations and completed a public process; and

WHEREAS, customers with total energy use or sales of less than 25 gigawatthours per year and who are not members of joint action agencies or member-based associations may submit a less complicated Small Customer Plan. Under both reporting methods, customers must submit annual progress reports on the anniversary date of the plan's approval; and

WHEREAS, Western may impose penalties if a customer fails to submit an acceptable plan, or if customer actions are inconsistent with their submitted plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN CITY, KANSAS:


Section 1. That the Baldwin City Council, does hereby authorize the approval of the IRP to the Western Area Power Administration.
